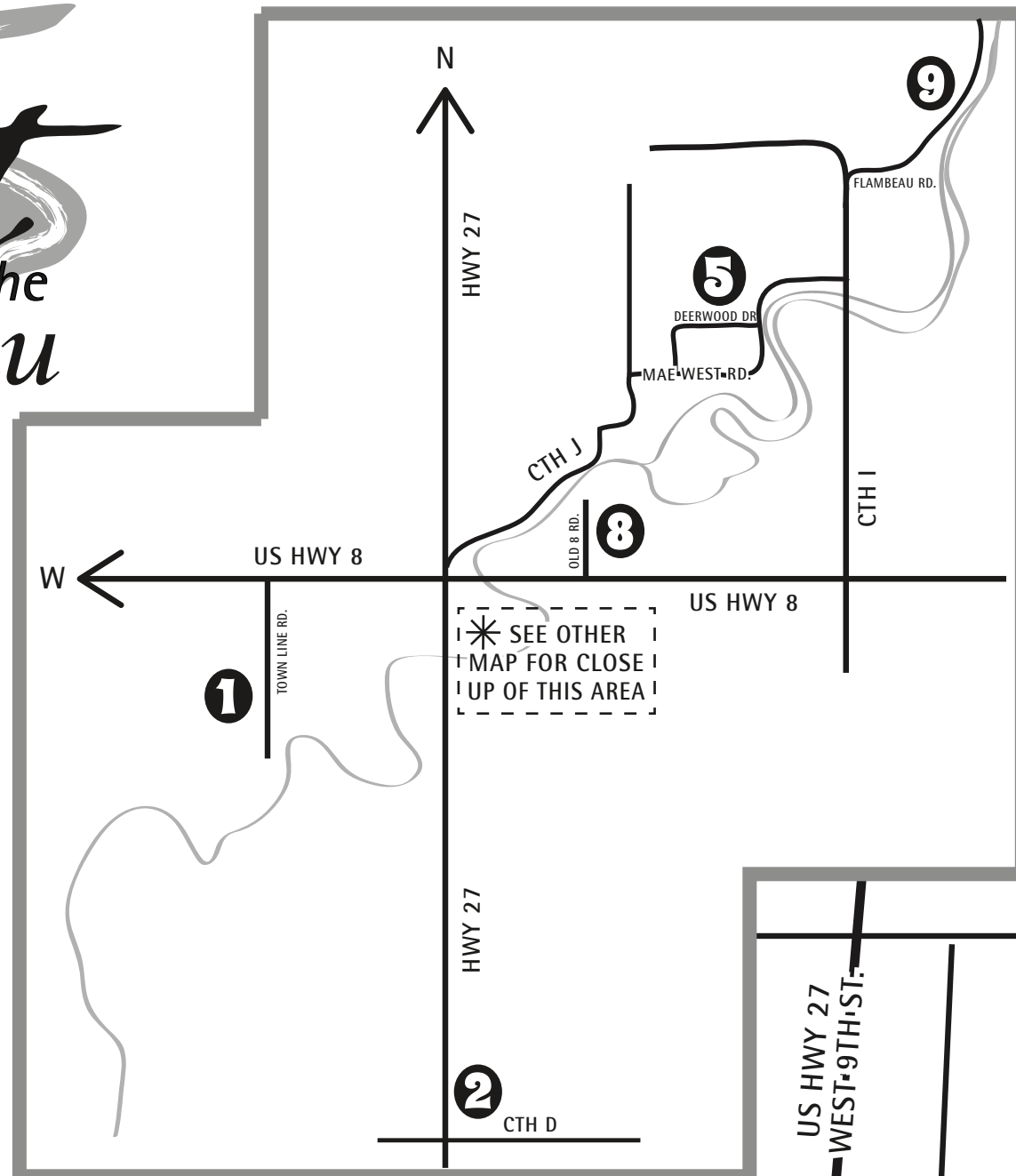
Jason Gillis, Flambeau Pottery Works

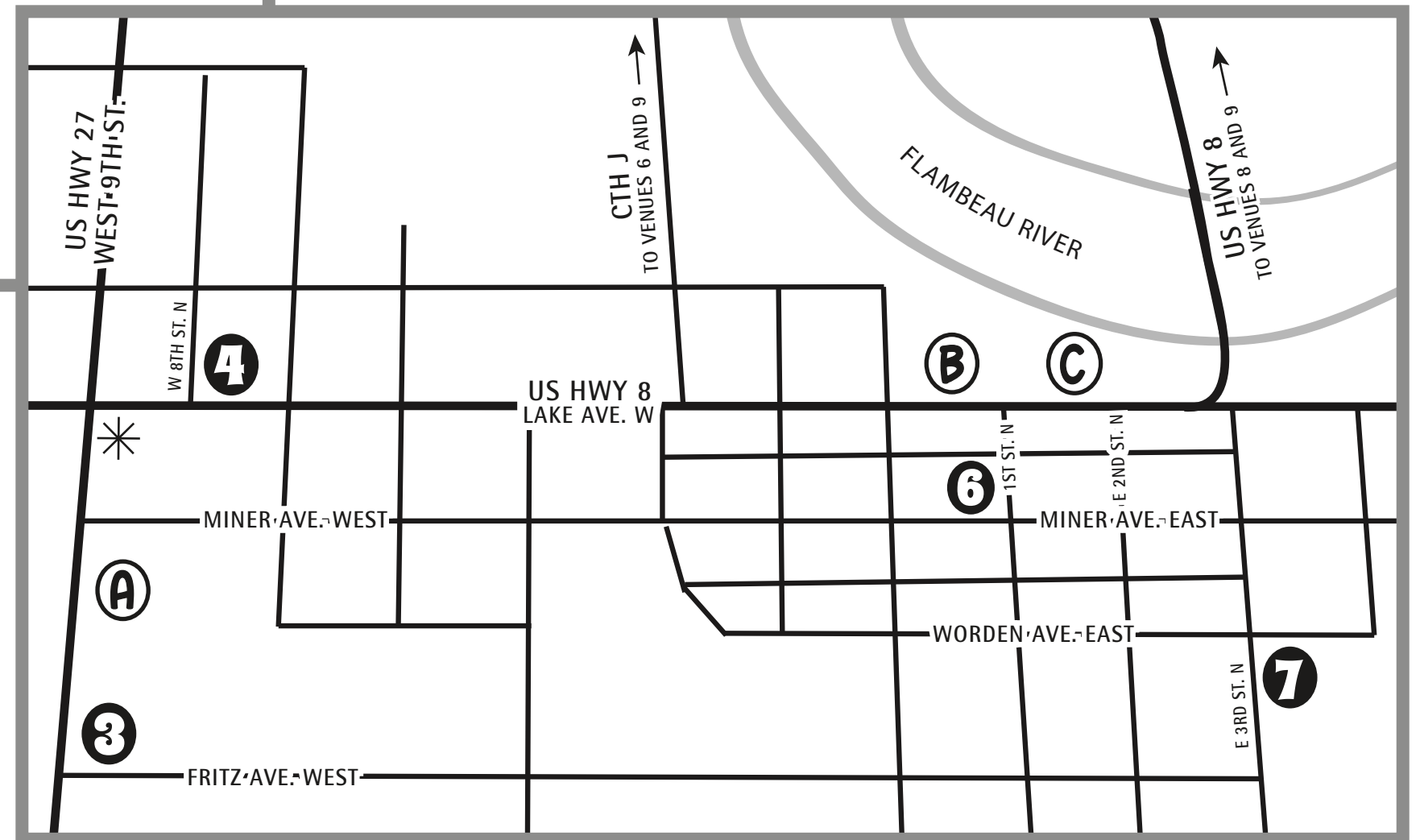
